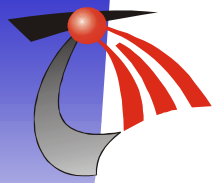

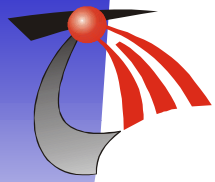

- **XML DTD for SNMP MIBs**
- **SMIng**

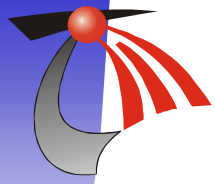


WHY DID WE START SMIng?

- **SMIv2 RELIED ON 1988 VERSION OF ASN.1**
- **TOOLS FOR SMIv2 RELATIVELY COMPLEX**
- **CERTAIN DATA TYPES WERE MISSING IN SMIv2**
64 bit integers, ...
- **LIMITED FACILITIES TO REUSE DEFINITIONS**
- **SMIv2 DID NOT ALLOW FOR EXTENSIONS**
- **NEW, POSSIBLY INCOMPATIBLE VARIANTS APPEARED**

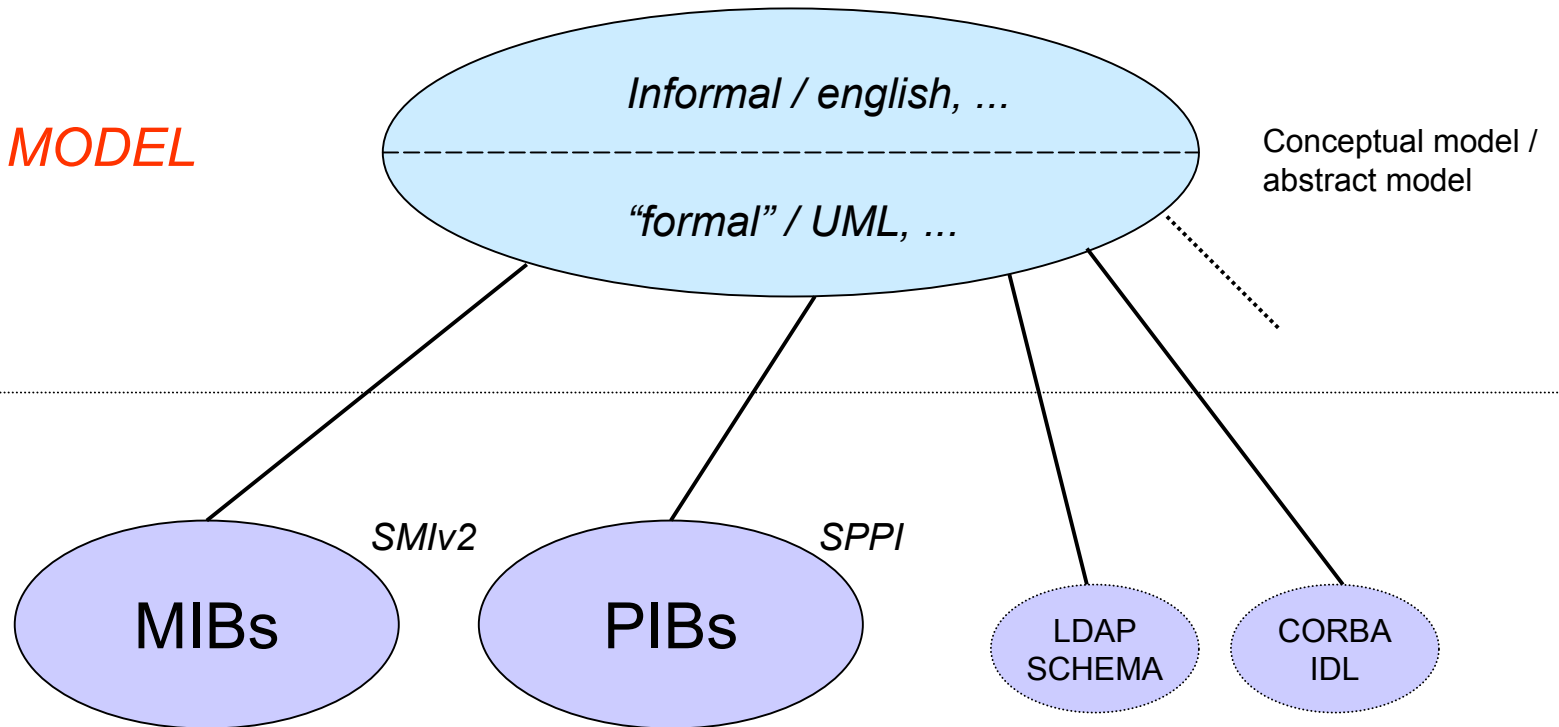
**CREATE A COMMON DATA DEFINITION LANGUAGE,

DATA VERSUS INFORMATION MODEL

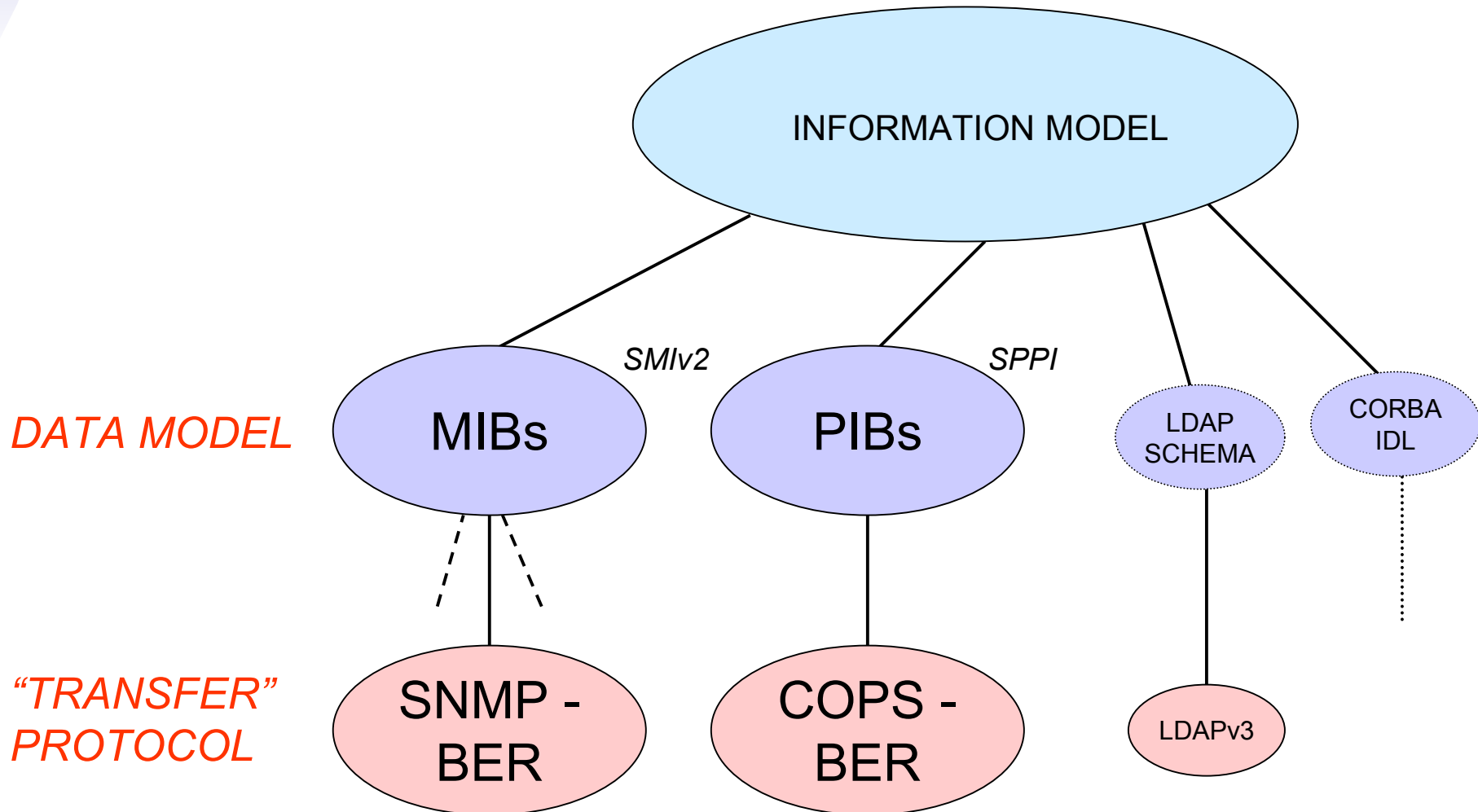
INFORMATION MODEL

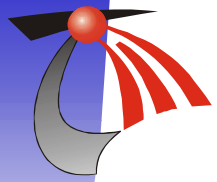
DATA MODEL





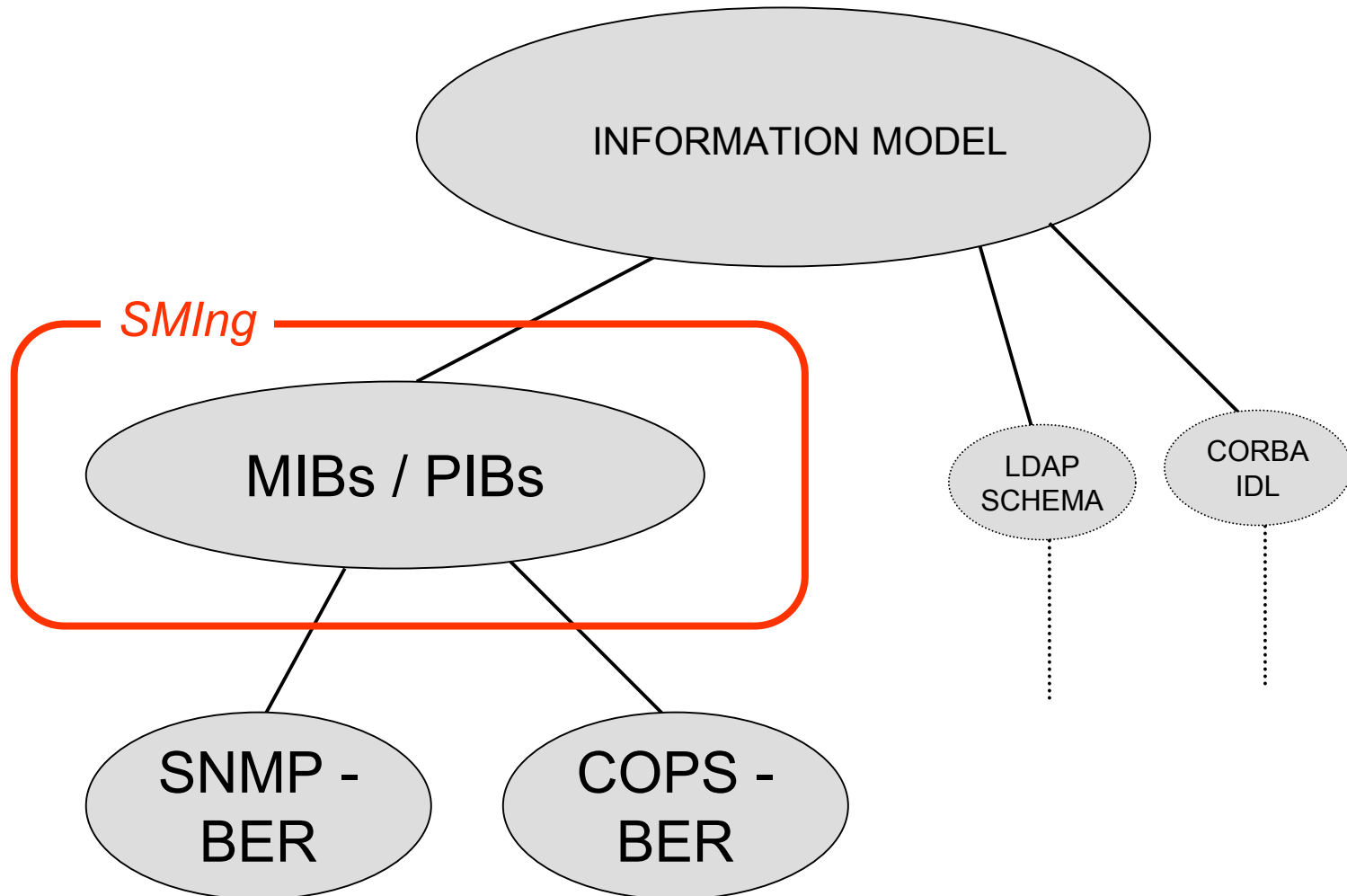
DATA MODEL & "TRANSFER" PROTOCOL
