DEVELOPED BY IRTF-NMRG

- SNMP over TCP
- SNMP compression
- SNMP GetSubTree
- XML DTD for SNMP MIBs
- SMIng





WHY DID WE START SMIng?

- SMIv2 RELIED ON 1988 VERSION OF ASN.1
- TOOLS FOR SMIv2 RELATIVELY COMPLEX
- CERTAIN DATA TYPES WERE MISSING IN SMIv2

64 bit integers, ...

- LIMITED FACILITIES TO REUSE DEFINITIONS
- SMIv2 DID NOT ALLOW FOR EXTENSIONS
- NEW, POSSIBLY INCOMPATIBLE VARIANTS APPEARED


THE CHALLANGE:

CREATE A COMMON DATA DEFINITION LANGUAGE, INDEPENDENT OF SPECIFIC PROTOCOLS






DATA VERSUS INFORMATION MODEL







DATA MODEL & "TRANSFER" PROTOCOL


